1. **Greetings and Introductions:** Shelli Whaley, Procurement Officer
 - a. Purpose of this pre-proposal conference – to answer questions openly and provide clarification on the IFB.
 - b. No verbal statements made shall change the solicitation.
 - c. Note that this pre-bid conference is not mandatory for bidding.
2. **IFB Overview:**
 - a. Solicitation documents are available at: <https://procurement.opengov.com/portal/mohavecounty>
 - b. Mohave County is soliciting bids from qualified firms to enter into an agreement for timely removal and recycling of all Waste Tires located at the Mohave County Waste Tire Collection Sites (WTCS), to ensure that the yearly volume of tires removed from each location is equal to or greater than the acceptance rate at each WTCS.
 - c. Overview of sections of the IFB.
3. **IFB Questions:**
 - a. All questions concerning the IFB are to be submitted in writing, preferably through email or OpenGov.
 - b. Questions are due by January 28, 2025 at 11:59 pm.
 - c. Answers will be made through a solicitation addendum and will be made public.
4. **IFB Submission:**
 - a. **Proposals are due February 4, 2025 at 2:00 p.m. Local AZ Time.**
 - b. Late proposals will not be considered for any reason.
 - c. Options for submission:
 - i. Submit electronically through the County's online bidding system at: <https://procurement.opengov.com/portal/mohavecounty>, or;
 - ii. Submit physically on paper through mail, delivery service, or in-person.
 - d. Kingman is considered rural by delivery carriers - express and next day not guaranteed.
 - e. Check the County's procurement portal before submitting a proposal, include any addenda that have been issued.
 - f. Do not use the Mohave County Seal in your proposal – use of the Seal is restricted.
5. **Award:**
 - a. Award will be made to the lowest-cost bid from a responsive and responsible bidder.
 - b. The recommendation for award requires approval by the Mohave County Board of Supervisors, anticipated at the March 3, 2025 Board meeting.
