 - b. Late submittals will not be considered for any reason.

 - d. The Evaluation of Qualifications section of the RFQ lists submittal requirements.
 - e. Do not use the Mohave County Seal in your proposal – use of the Seal is restricted.
5. **Evaluation and Award:**
 - a. Evaluation will be made by a committee that will rank the proposals according to the Evaluation of Proposals section of the RFQ, based on the information in your proposals.
 - b. County may negotiate with top-ranked offeror. If negotiations fail with the top-ranked offeror, County may move on to the next.
 - c. The Evaluation Committee's recommendation for award requires approval by the Mohave County Board of Supervisors, anticipated at the January 5th, 2026 Board meeting.
